1. At the outset, the ADC, CCO welcomed all participants and introduced the Chair, who has recently assumed charge as Principal Chief Commissioner of Customs, Kolkata Customs Zone, to the stakeholders of CCFC. The participants were invited to introduce themselves. This was followed by a presentation highlighting the recent trade facilitation initiatives undertaken by the zone through issuance of Public Notices. He then requested the Chair to address the meeting.
2. The Chair extended a warm welcome to all and expressed his appreciation for significant attendance. He reiterated the objective of this special session of CCFC meeting being convened on weekly basis which is to address the trade grievances related to import/export operations particularly in the light of evolving situation in West Asia.
3. He then invited the representatives of trade associations/bodies to raise issues, if any, that needs to be addressed.
4. Mr. Rajhans (TM, SMPK) mentioned that there is no trade related grievance attributable to the situation in the Gulf region at present. He confirmed that the port operations remain under control and the issues warranting action has already been resolved through joint action with the Customs administration. No further issues were reported by the other participants.
5. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair and all stakeholders.
